To peak your interest about what the acronym of the foundation really stands for ild was translated into 'i love ducklings'. Every spring a new duckling generation represents new life, and at the same time vulnerability. The goal of the ild care foundation is to make people more aware of the potential damage poor air quality can do to our lungs. Many factors contribute to poor air quality, including microscopic pollutants found in the air around you, including fine dust, airborne mold, fumes, silica, man made mineral fibers, gasses, herbicides, and pesticides.
